Message From The Board

Jashan-e-Mehregan greeting to everyone,

We welcome our autumn equinox harvest festival with a celebration on October 7th. I hope to see a large gathering for this event. Of Course, the day started with Prayers from Mobed Poras Balsara...Thank You, Mobed Balsara! ... followed by classes, lunch, and birthday cake. Many thanks to our religious teachers, Pearl Balsara, Delnaaz Irani, and Nina Kalianivala, for their time and effort in making our classes a success. Please note that our October children's religious class is scheduled for the 1st of October so we do not have conflicting events on the same weekend. This year, our Z-Camp is scheduled in November, the weekend before Thanksgiving. Please refer to the subsequent sections of this newsletter for details of the camp and other programs.

With the football season and other sports events starting, sometimes members would like to meet up in the center. As always, the Center is open for members, but for any large gathering, the following protocols have to be followed. Members who have purchased or have cards from their donation levels can visit the Prayer Room to offer services. A board permission is not needed for the Prayer room visit as the room is never rented and always available to provide services. Our Board recommends that anyone using the prayer room should do so during regular hours from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. The Board had to be informed of any visits beyond this time as we have a security system with cameras in place and constantly monitor the Center for safety. The members are responsible for keeping the Center clean and ensuring that is locked after their visit. Please follow all the Operating Guidelines, which are also included in our ZANT Directory and available on our website. Social Use: If a group of Members wants to get together at the Center for Social Events, they are responsible for notifying the board at least 5 days before the event and getting permission (email to board.zant@gmail.com). This is needed since the board has to confirm that there are no conflicts in relation to other ZANT events or private rentals and that the center is clean. Members must also ensure that the Center is left clean and that there are no damages following a social gathering. Only ZANT members are allowed for smaller social gatherings without rental fees. Any large private event with non-members present will be considered a rental and charged rental rates.

Reminder: Members who have requested and paid for access cards are requested to set up appointments with the ZANT Board so we can meet at the Center, program the cards, and distribute them. We are not mailing cards to ensure they are not in the wrong hands. Thank You for your patience.

For members with yearly membership, note that the membership for FY 2023 ends October 31st. Everyone is requested to check the membership application in the newsletter and complete it ASAP. For your convenience, we also have made provisions to complete the membership application via the web and utilize Zelle for electronic payment. The details are noted in the form.

Eclipse Watch

On Saturday, October 14, 2023, a partial solar eclipse will be visible in our local area. Some of us will be at ZANT Center as the parking lot, and grounds are well-situated to watch it. However, special precautions MUST be taken to see any type of solar eclipse. See below for the reason we must be careful.

The Sun always gives off visible, infrared, and ultraviolet radiation. Under typical everyday conditions, if you look at the Sun even for a second, the pupil of the eye constricts and your eyelids close, and thus there is no damage to the eye. But during a solar eclipse, the Moon covers up the Sun, and therefore, the light emitted by the Sun decreases. This causes the pupils to dilate and allows more light to enter the eye and strike the retina. Since there are no pain cells on the retina, you feel no pain, even though the radiation could be causing permanent damage. Hence, you must NOT look directly at the Sun during a solar eclipse. Solar filters or special eclipse glasses can be used to view it safely. Sunglasses do NOT give adequate protection.

The eclipse begins at 10:23 a.m., mid-eclipse is at 11:52 a.m., and ends at 1:27 p.m. To reserve your special eclipse glasses, please contact Anahita Sidhwa at <u>afsidhwa@vezon.net</u>.

Mehregan is one of the two most ancient Iranian festivals known, dating back at least as far as the earliest Iranians. Mehregan is an Iranian festival celebrated in honor of Mithra, the divinity of covenant, and hence of interpersonal relationships such as friendship, affection, and love. The word "Mehr" (in Mehregan) represents knowledge, love, light and friendship.





"Cyrus the Great" Day Celebration:

Cyrus the Great Day, also known as Cyrus Day, is an Iranian observance held in October. It is dedicated to the Persian King Cyrus II, who became famous as the founder of the Achaemenid Empire.

Cyrus the Great Day is the anniversary of Cyrus's entrance into Babylon. Cyrus the Great took Babylon, the ancient capital of the Babylonian state covering modern Lebanon, Syria, Iraq, and Israel, in October 539 BC. Cyrus II is known not only as a great conqueror but as the author of the Cyrus Cylinder, considered by some the world's first declaration of universal human rights.



Cyrus Day is mainly celebrated in Iran and by Iranian communities in other countries. In Iran, those who want to honor the memory of Cyrus the Great come to his tomb in Pasargadae, the ancient capital of the Achaemenid Empire.

Justice, and Human Rights!


