Lastly, we would like to remind everyone to mark their calendars for Jashn-e-Sadeh and the Annual General Meeting on January 27th, 2024.



"Cyrus the Great" Day Celebration:

Cyrus the Great Day, also known as Cyrus Day, is an Iranian observance held in October. It is dedicated to the Persian King Cyrus II, who became famous as the founder of the

Achaemenid Empire.

Cyrus the Great Day is the anniversary of Cyrus's entrance into Babylon. Cyrus the Great took Babylon, the ancient capital of the Babylonian state covering modern Lebanon, Syria, Iraq, and Israel, in October 539 BC. Cyrus II is known not only as a great conqueror but as the author of the Cyrus Cylinder, considered by some the world's first declaration of universal human rights.



Cyrus Day is mainly celebrated in Iran and by Iranian communities in other countries. In Iran, those who want to honor the memory of Cyrus the Great come to his tomb in Pasargadae, the ancient capital of the Achaemenid Empire.

Let's get together and celebrate "Cyrus Day" and remember the Great Champion of Freedom,

Justice, and Human Rights!


