Message From The Board

Dear Members,

Hope the New Year is going well for all. As many of you know the water damage to our Center had resulted in canceling or moving our planned programs to other facilities when available. Due to unavailability of a suitable venue at a low cost ZANT has decided to cancel our Super Bowl event and the ZANT religious classes for the month of February. We hope to have our Center fully repaired in a reasonable duration so we can continue with our programs. Practices for the Nouruz function is continuing at the residence of the Balsara's and other facilities arranged by our members. Thanks to the arrangements done by the Buhariwalla's we were able to host our AGM at the Wellington Club house in January. In spite of the last-minute venue change, a lot of members were at the AGM, and it was a productive meeting. ZANT's annual budget was approved, and members were also provided an update on the center. After the AGM many of us celebrated Sadeh at the Heritage Park where we were joined by many more families to enjoy the event. Families gathered and prayed in front of the fire led by our Mobedyar Pantheha. Prayer and songs were followed by warm OoshAush, Pizza and hot Tea. Thanks to the effort of Anahita Kayani, Raha Pouladi, Pantheha Soroushpoor, Keshvar Buhariwalla, Pearl Balsara and many others for making this event a success. It was a very cold evening and two things were evident.

Item 1 - was the luxury of heat we have at our Center along with bathroom and kitchen facilities which makes such event possible even in inclement weather.

Item 2 - was the importance of fire in the early years of our religion where people did not have the luxury of the modern day heating facilities.

Center Update:

- Center has been dried up and ready for repairs. Renovation will begin as soon as Insurance approval is obtained.
- Insurance adjusted has visited the site and completed analysis of damage. We are awaiting damage estimate from our agent along with their approval to start repairs.
- Building Committee met with our sprinkler contractor to discuss options that can be taken to greatly reduce the potential for frozen sprinkler pipes in event of very cold weather. ZANT building committee will evaluate the options and proceed with changes once we have the estimated cost.
- Building Committee met with a few general contractors and obtained their estimate for repairs and higher grade insulation within the attic.

We hope to see a lot of progress being made in February to get the center ready for occupancy. The duration of repairs is still unknown, and membership will be updated on a monthly basis. We appreciate all our members who have stepped up to help during these tough times and encourage everyone to send in donations to defray some of the cost associated with repairs. We would like to celebrate Spendarmazdgan Day, the Zoroastrian Day of Love, in February. May this day bring you and your loved ones abundant blessings, peace, and spiritual fulfillment.
